Herb Cilantro

Cilantro refers to the fresh leafy portion of this annual herb. Coriander typically refers to the seed, which is used as a dry spice. Plant this fast growing herb from seed and enjoy both the herb and the spice in you cooking. Typical plants usually reach 20 to 22 inches when flowering.



Pepper Ancho Sanchez F1

An early maturing Ancho/Poblano type. Large heavy setting plants, excellent cover for the giant 5.5 x 3 inch pointed fruit. Wall thickness is at least ¼ inch. Dark green fruit turn finally deep red. Excellent for cooking. Green fruit are usually used fresh like Poblano, while red fruit are dried and then utilized. TMV resistant.



Tomato Viva Salsa F1

72 days to maturity. An adaptable, determinate Roma tomato that is great for the market or home garden markets. Viva Salsa F1 is a large red pear shaped fruit, usually having an average weight of 4 ounces. Multiple disease resistance. Fruit are very uniform and of high quality which can be used fresh or cooked.



Pepper Santiago F1

Sixty five days to maturity Jalapeno hybrid. Large sturdy plants bears thick Jalapeno shaped, smooth fruit, up to three inches long, medium thick walls, turns from green to red at full maturity, very pungent, both fresh market and pickling uses.



Onion Walla Walla

True intermediate day yellow onion, which was made popular by the growing region near Walla Walla, Washington. Skin is a light yellow color and the flesh is white. Know for its sweet flavor and huge bulbs, Walla Walla is coveted for its versatility in the kitchen. Grows well in latitudes above 35 degrees.



Cucumber Crystal Apple

55 days to maturity. 2 to 3 inch heirloom fruits ripen to ivory/white just like it heirloom sister Lemon. Sweet white flesh is easy to digest and very tasty even when picked with fully mature seeds. Can be used for novelty pickles or sliced and used fresh. Vigorous vines are drought and rust resistant.



Cabbage Green Express

53 days to maturity, very early to head. The first super early open pollinated green cabbage to be released in years. Small plant frame, dense, solid, oval heads, light green color, 2 to 3 pounds. Bred for Canada & Northern US. Green Express is very adaptable to many North American locations.



Radish Rudolph

25 days to maturity, bright red skin, firm white flesh stays sweet and crisp for an extended time, dark green strong small sized tops, larger than most early red globe types, can be planted in either spring or fall. Makes a fun garden treat for kids.
