

# Warm Season Containers



**Squash Black Coral**

45 days to maturity. Black Coral is a dark black zucchini hybrid with a glossy skin. It grows to be 7 to 8 inches long. The plant produces a heavy yield and tastes great. Black Coral has a very high percentage of number one fancy fruit plus excellent mildew tolerance on an open bush habit for ease in picking



**Pumpkin Wee Be Little**

This 1999 national AAS winner is ideal for cooking, painting and carving. Wee Be Little weighs 1 pound, being small enough to hold in your hands. Their vines are semi-bush habit, meaning they don't need a lot of space in the garden to grow.



**Tomato Patio Choice Yellow F1**

2017 AAS national winner Patio Choice Yellow is compact and developed specifically for small spaces and container gardens. The plant produces a very large yield of half ounce bright yellow cherry tomatoes on short vines that grows to be 18 inches tall. Consider using these tomatoes fresh, in the oven, or sun dried for a deliciously sweet treat.



**Pepper Mexican Sunrise F1**

Announced as a 2018 AAS regional winner, Mexican Sunrise F1 brings to the garden a full spectrum of colors from lime green to yellow then orange and red as the fruit matures. The conical pendant shaped peppers are thick walled and semi-hot. They can be eaten at any stage. Vegetable gardeners are sure to love this attractive fruit.



**Herb Basil Lettuce Leaf**

75 days to maturity. A basil with a great flavor and fragrance, Lettuce Leaf is 4 to 6 inches long. The leaves are slightly serrated and crinkled. Lettuce Leaf is more sweet than spicy. It can be used for pesto, sandwiches and casseroles. They are also great dried and crumbled to be used as spice.



**Cucumber Bush Hog**

Bush Hog are cute little cucumbers with prickly outsides. They are bitter and are best when pickled. Each fruit is about 2 to 3 inches long and are fun to decorate with as well. Kids would love the look of these cucumbers, as they look like little hedgehogs. The plants are short and compact.



**Corn Japonica Stripped**

85 days to maturity. Japonica Stripped Maize is a beautiful ornamental corn from Japan. They grow to be 5 to 6 feet tall. The leaves are variegated with green, white, yellow and pink. The tassels are a dark purple with burgundy kernels. The corn has better color development when the plants are widely spread.



**Eggplant Red Ruffles**

75 days to maturity. This eggplant is a beautiful red-orange shade, being only 2 to 3 inches round. It contains a great flavor and is well known in Asian cuisine and in stir-fries. The eggplant is not bitter unless left until the bright red stage. Pick them green and use like you would any other eggplant.
